Nanotec-USA brings back their Nanoprotect retail grade products which were engineered for the do-it-yourself installer. Mr. Moore, President of Nanotec-USA stated, "I authorized the staff to re-start production of our Economy Grade Nanoprotect products for clients wanting a less expensive product that will still offer 12-16 months function."

Nanotec-USA had discontinued the Nanoprotect line 2 years ago after they received reports that one of their offshore affiliates had decided to change the Nanoprotect product line by filling their own bottles with a lower quality product than that used in the original Nanoprotect line. This offshore company was a major distributor of the Nanoprotect product line and recently went out of business.

Mr. Moore felt it was his duty to bring back the Nanoprotect line of products to ensure that the offshore company's former clients would be able to purchase the Nanoprotect treatments. Nanotec-USA has consulted with their chemists about the formulation of the Nanoprotect product line. It was decided that a higher grade product would be offered under the former Nanoprotect name.

The difference in the NanoBionics line and the Nanoprotect line is the concentration of self-assembling Nano-particles suspended within the solution. The Nano-particles in the NanoBionics line are of the highest quality available and offer longer-term function. The Nanoprotect line will be offered to the consumer who is looking for a great product at a fraction of the cost of the Professional Grade NanoBionics treatments.

Re-sellers and former distributors of the offshore company are welcome to apply for wholesale discounts. "There is no reason to leave those guys out in the cold with no supplier. Let's make sure they have the inventory they need to continue their businesses but give them a better product!" said Mr. Moore.

Nanotec-USA will begin by offering the original Nanoprotect AG and Nanoprotect Plastic treatments January 21, 2009. The other treatments will be available by special order.
